Prof. Željko Bačić graduated at the Faculty of Geodesy, University of Zagreb in 1986, and took his PhD at the Technical University of Graz, Austria in 1997. Since then, he is teaching Satellite Positioning, Sensor integration and Navigation at the Faculty of Geodesy in Zagreb and Faculty of Civil Engineering, Architecture and Geodesy in Split.

In period 1999.-2012. he was Director General of Croatian State Geodetic Administration during which time new legislation was adopted, cadastre service reorganized, and comprehensive reform of land administration in Croatia was conducted. Croatian permanent GNSS network – CROPOS and National SDI have been established.

He was active member of EuroGeographics, was member of Management board 2002-2007, and its President 2005-2007, was member of Cambridge Conference Advisory Board 2003-2011, and chairmen of the Management board on regional cooperation in Cadastre in South-East Europe 2007-2012.
